ROLE AND RESPONSIBILITIES

This role is responsible for monitoring workplace activities and ensuring compliance with safety protocols and procedures on the job site located in Springfield, NE.

- Assist the Safety Director in creating and implementing the site-specific safety program.
- Establish safety pre-planning meetings with project management and subcontractors to discuss high risk activities and site safety requirements.
- Attend daily safety meetings and pre-job briefings.
- Facilitate weekly toolbox talks on specific safety topics.
- Oversee Project Safety Leads and provide guidance.
- Manage a safety team and establish roles and responsibilities for each safety representative.
- Ensure safety trainings and orientations meet project expectations.
- Educate workers about the company's safety policy and procedures.
- Assist in developing and implementing safety and loss prevention programs.
- Monitor safety performance of on-site workers to determine vulnerability.
- Identify and remove unsafe or hazardous materials from job sites prior to each shift when necessary.
- Inspect workplace and premises at beginning of each day to make sure it is safe for operation.
- Perform inspection on machinery, equipment and tools that workers will use to ensure they are safe to operate.
- Perform accident investigations to gauge measures that need to be taken to prevent them from reoccurring.
- Write detailed reports on daily activities, inspections and on-site accidents.
- Conduct safety audits on a periodic basis.
- Ensure storage of hazardous materials and dangerous equipment in specially designated storage areas.
- Communicate essential safety standards to workers during each walkthrough stage.

QUALIFICATIONS AND EDUCATION REQUIREMENT

- 5 years of construction safety experience.
- Ability to train, influence and motivate team members.
- Demonstrates industry knowledge and independent judgment to make decisions.

- Strong oral and written communication skills with ability to communicate with individuals with a variety of backgrounds.

PREFERRED SKILLS

- Bachelors or Master's Degree in Occupational Safety, Environmental Health, Risk Management or related field.
- Safety experience within the electrical industry preferred.

PHYSICAL REQUIREMENTS
